Parents:

Student safety has always been our number one priority at Rogich Middle School. Every student deserves a safe environment in which to learn and grow. We continually strive to implement safety measures that address our needs and benefit all students. I do have a couple of concerns I would like to share with the hopes of greater resolution.

Our traffic issues in the morning continue to present concerns. As I have personally began to assist with the crosswalk traffic as parents drop students off in the morning, I have great concern for parents who continue to drop students right in the middle of the moving traffic. Students are crossing in front of cars often caught in the middle of the street standing on the median. Please use the drop off lanes or pull to the curb on the outside of the traffic lanes rather than the middle lane or the lane by the median. We will continue to assist as students cross Pavilion Center. I am quite enjoying my opportunity to visit with students and parents as I assist with the cross walk, and will continue to do so.

Rogich Middle School does not begin until 9:10 AM. We are considered a late start school. Only students with an early bird class are allowed on campus at 8:00 AM. At that time, the exterior doors are locked and students are not allowed on campus until 8:50. We do not provide supervision outside until 8:45 AM. The majority of our staff does not begin their work day until 8:30 AM.

We have noticed that more and more students are arriving prior to that time. We've had students arriving as early as 7:30 who do not have an early bird class. Students outside without supervision is a concern. Please do not drop off or allow your students to arrive early to simply "hang out" with friends. This presents too many opportunities for problems as well as safety concerns.

We have noticed several students dropped off or arriving early are leaving the campus environment and walking toward the shopping area north on Pavilion Center. Parents are unaware that once students are dropped off they leave campus due to the great amount of time prior to the start of the school day.

If you need to drop students off earlier than 8:45- 8:50, please contact our Counselors and enroll your child in an early bird class. We appreciate your support as we strive to increase safety measures on campus.
